Fulton FUMC Celebrate Recovery Kids/Youth Volunteer Job Description

Overview: Serve the children and youth of Fulton FUMC's Celebrate Recovery Program by your presence and consistency in worship, devotionals, and activities on Friday Nights.

Description and Responsibilities:

- Work with approximately 8-10 students between the ages of 5-16 years old.
 - Including: Attending the first part of worship, walking students from sanctuary to Willingham Center, sharing a short devotional time together, and participating in various activities such as card games, basketball, or movies, etc.
- Attend Celebrate Recovery approximately 1-2 times a month as part of a rotation of 2-3 volunteers that will serve alongside the CR Kids/Youth Director.
 - This regularly includes working with both the Youth Director and CR Kids/Youth Director.
- Possess the ability to pass a state/federal background check.
- Be willing to serve as a "backup" volunteer in the event that a regularly scheduled Celebrate Recovery meeting will not be considered "Safe Sanctuary" - i.e. there won't be enough adults present at an event due to an originally scheduled volunteers' inability to be present.
- Willingness and ability to communicate with students and other volunteers clearly and effectively.

Weekly/Monthly Time Commitment:

- Celebrate Recovery is a weekly program that occurs on Friday nights at Fulton FUMC from 6:30PM-8:30PM, volunteers will stay with students for the entire duration of the program, or until all students have been collected by their parent/guardian (approximately 2-2.5 hrs).
- Pending the number of volunteers on rotation, this will be a once or twice monthly commitment.
