The Ken-Tenn Food Bank is now in its 12th year of serving commodities, serving over 350 families each month in Fulton, Hickman, Fulton County, and South Fulton. This is accomplished through three programs each month at the Food Bank: CSFP, TEFAP, and One for 84.

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The Commodities for the Seniors Food Program (CSFP)

The CSFP distributes commodities monthly on the **3rd Friday of each month, from 9 – 11 a.m.** to residents age 60 or older who live in **Fulton, Hickman, or Fulton County** and earn less than \$1,986 monthly.

To apply for this program, come to the food bank on the 3rd Friday between 9 – 11 a.m. with **proof of residence, proof of age, driver's license, and utility bill.**

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

TEFAP is for people and families of all ages in need in **Fulton, Hickman, and Fulton County.** This program meets on the **4th Friday of each month, from 9 – 11 a.m.** Please bring with you **proof of residence, proof of age, driver's license, and utility bill.** See the following page for financial requirements.

The One for 84 Program

The One for 84 Program for **South Fulton** residents is held on the **1st Saturday of each month, from 9 – 10:30 a.m.** serving those who earn \$1,986 or less for 1 person. To register, bring **proof of residence and proof of income.**

TFAP Financial Requirements

Household income determines the financial requirements and number of persons in the household determines the number of boxes received.

<u>Number of People</u>	<u>Maximum Income</u>
Family of 1	\$1,986
Family of 2	\$2,686
Family of 3	\$3,386
Family of 4	\$4,086
Family of 5	\$4,786
Family of 6	\$5,486

You must have **proof of residence**, along with **names and Social Security numbers of all people in the household**, and **proof of income**.
