Fulton FUMC Youth Volunteer Job Description

Overview: Serve the youth of Fulton FUMC by regularly attending the weekly UMYF programming, monitoring and participating in group discussions, and being willing to invest in the students through conversation and your supporting presence.

Description and Responsibilities:

- Attend UMYF gatherings, acting as both supervision and an approachable adult.
- Assist the Youth Director in keeping students focused during lesson time.
- Participate in group discussions or activities with the students during lessons, to build their confidence and encourage students to speak, ask questions, and answer questions about faith and theology.
- Participate in "just for fun" activities with the youth as you are able including but not limited to: playing cards/board games, 9-square, basketball, etc.
- Assist the Youth Director in "closing time" actions reminding students to take out trash, making sure the spaces we use are left in better shape than they are found in.
- Possess the ability to pass a state/federal background check.
- Provide a meal for UMYF (individually or with your Sunday School class) approx. every 2-3 months or as you are willing/able.
- Inform the Youth Director of any days/weeks you will be unavailable as soon as possible so that they may plan accordingly.
- Support the Youth Director by providing advice, your friendly presence, and sharing ideas for the ministry as you have them.

Weekly Time Commitment:

- The Youth Director makes a volunteer rotation prior to the beginning of each month. You choose how often you serve, whether weekly, biweekly, monthly, only Sundays, only Wednesdays, etc. and the youth director will plan the schedule accordingly.
- UMYF gathers on Sunday nights from 5:30-7:30, and Wednesday nights from 5:30-7:00. If you choose to do so, attending both gatherings will be a weekly time commitment of approximately 3.5 hours.
